Fees Relevant to Court of Appeal Matters



Effective 1 July 2011

Hearing Fees - For hearing an appeal by the Court of Appeal

- for every day or part of a day *after the first day* **\$389.80**

No fee is payable in respect of a proceeding under

1. Rule 75.05 of Chapter I - Contempt of Court.
2. Section 92 of the Magistrates' Court Act 1989 (Criminal).

Late Filing Fee

In addition to any other fee payable where the Registry opens outside the hours 9.30 am to 4.00 pm:

- within 1/2 hour before opening time or within 1/2 hour after closing time **\$63.50**
- at any other time **\$629.30**

Notice of Appeal

- to the Court of Appeal **\$3146.70**

No fee is payable to commence an appeal:

1. under Section 92 of the Magistrates' Court Act 1989 (criminal)
2. under Parts 4, 5 and 6 of Order 58 of Chapter I of Williams, *Civil Procedure Victoria*.

Photocopying

- Per page **\$1.50**

Searching a Court File

- If the correct file number is quoted in the request **\$31.80**
- If no number or an incorrect file number is quoted in the request **\$50.10**

Setting Down

- Setting down or otherwise entering a proceeding into the Court of Appeal List.
Includes the first day hearing fees. **\$755.20**

Summons

- interlocutory application **\$333.60**
- commencing a proceeding under Order 65 **\$767.40**

No fee is payable to file a Summons for the following:

1. Order 57 - an application for an order that a Writ of Habeas Corpus shall issue
2. An application in relation to an appeal under Section 92 of the Magistrates' Court Act 1989 (criminal)
3. Rule 75.05 of Chapter I - Contempt of Court
4. Rule 80.03(4) of Chapter I - An application for an order for substituted service of foreign process made by the Attorney General
5. Order 5 of Chapter II - Case stated by a Tribunal
6. Order 6 of Chapter II - Reference by a Tribunal of a question of law
7. Order 12 of Chapter II - Jury Service Appeals
8. Order 1 of Chapter IV - Adoption Rules
