



NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION

The Judges in Charge of the Judicial Review and Appeals List, the Honourable Justice Cavanough and the Honourable Justice Kyrou, advise the profession as follows:

Practice Note No. 4 of 2009 – Judicial Review and Appeals List

1. Effective immediately, the standard directions in the Judicial Review and Appeals List, which are contained in Annexure A to Practice Note 4 of 2009, will include the following additional direction:

The Notice of Trial shall be in Form 48B.

2. The purpose of the additional direction is to depart from what would otherwise be the default position under rule 48.03 of the *Supreme Court (General Civil Procedure) Rules 2005*, namely, that a Notice of Trial must be in Form 48A. The Court has received feedback from the profession, with which the Court agrees, that Form 48B is more appropriate and convenient for proceedings that fall within the Judicial Review and Appeals List.
