## **Notice to Practitioners 2001**

### **Corporations Business Notice to Practitioners**

1. From 4 February 2002 the Honourable Justice Hansen will be the Judge in charge of Corporations business.
2. To the extent practicable his Honour will deal with both interlocutory and final hearings.
3. From 4 February 2002 all Corporations work of a kind required to be heard by a Judge (including appeals from a Master) is to be made returnable before his Honour in Court 3 of the Old High Court at 10.00 am on Fridays.
4. To facilitate the examination of files before a hearing, parties must file at the Prothonotary's Office all papers on which they intend to rely at the hearing (including copies of exhibits for the use of the Judge) no later than the time required by the rules or by 4.00 pm on the Wednesday preceding the return day, whichever is the earlier. If it is thought that there will be any argument of any substance on the return day, all parties should not later than 4.00 pm on the Wednesday preceding the return day serve a brief outline of submissions incorporating references to principal authorities relied upon and within the same time provide a copy to the Judge either by filing at the Prothonotary's Office or forwarding to his Honour's Associate by facsimile 9603 6056.
5. In the case of an application required to be heard urgently or otherwise than on a Friday, practitioners should contact his Honour's Associate (Peter Neustupný, telephone 9603 6150, facsimile 9603 6056) to make an arrangement for a hearing before his Honour or, if necessary, another Judge.
6. Urgent applications before a Master will be dealt with in the same way as is now done.
