This Notice concerns interrogatories served in Personal Injuries List proceedings under Order 30 of the *Supreme Court (General Civil Procedure) Rules 2005*.

The Judge in Charge of the Personal Injuries List ('the List'), the Honourable Justice Williams, advises the profession as follows:

- The number of interrogatories served in proceedings in the List should be limited to thirty (including sub-parts).
- In motor vehicle accident and industrial accident cases, interrogatories are only permitted in relation to questions of liability.
